Assessment Task

The role of the RDP today (Class activity) (LO2 AS2)

Discuss the role of the RDP. Study the information on debating skills below. Hold a class debate about the statement: 'The RDP should continue to play a role in South Africa today'.

Assess your own performance.

Debating skills:

- Debating takes place between two teams. One team proposes a motion and the other team opposes it.
- The motion for this debate is: 'The RDP should continue to play a role in South Africa today'.
- Each team should choose a team captain to lead the team.
- Each team should choose two or three additional speakers per team.
- Choose a secretary to keep minutes of the proceedings and note down the main points each team makes in defense of or opposition to the motion.
- Choose a time-keeper, who will be responsible for keeping every person from exceeding the time allocated for their speech.
- The team captain of the defending team will speak first.
- The length of the team captains' speeches should be limited to two minutes.
- The team captain from the opposing team will speak second.
- The rest of the speakers will then follow: one from the defending team and one from the opposing team, until all the speakers have spoken.
- The additional speakers each have one minute of speaking time.
